## Wallaloo Park Sale Results



2007 brought about a huge demand for rams. Strong auction sales with private demand solid well into February.

The Classings Classic at Murray Bridge SA, saw 10 rams sell for an average of \$4750, with a top of \$10,000 sold to, Superior Wools Syn, SA (see above).



The Wallaloo Park on property sale began buoyantly, with a sale a top of \$17,000 sold to Willie and Susan Macdonald 'Middlehurst Station' Blenheim NZ. Pictured above, the ram was sired by 265, carrying a lusturious 19.4 micron fleece and weighing in at 108kg.

The sale continued strongly, with many loyal and new clients purchasing both stud and very affordable flock rams.

94 rams sold for an average of \$2646.

2007 semen sales were once again strong with sales to VIC, SA, NSW, TAS and WA.

Well known New Zealand daughter Stud, Middlehurst Station recently exported 6 rams and 10 ewes to Southern France.

The French breeder did an extensive tour of Australian Studs before choosing Wallaloo Park Genetics.

Due to bans on exports between Australia and France, Middlehurst were issued with a once off export permit. This is the first time France has ever imported Merino genetics.
